1. Regular Membership

Any film commission and film related organization that support film and video shooting.

2. Associate Membership

- a. Film production companies, investment companies, TV production or film-related companies and directors, producers, location managers, and persons in related industries,
- b. Organizations and groups related to culture, tourism, or government,
- c. Individuals and groups who wish to participate in AFCNet.

- ▶ Any film commission, organization and individual wishing to become a regular member or associate member, should submit a written application to the AFCNet Secretariat.
- ▶ All regular members of AFCNet are required to pay annual fees US\$300.
- ▶ Admission of new membership applicants will be decided upon approval by the Board of Directors.
- ▶ All other related facts of membership will follow the regulations as stipulated in ARTICLE II of the AFCNet Bylaws.
